GUIDELINES FOR ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

• Word Limit: 300–500 words

• Keywords: 5–7

• Font Style: Times New Roman

• Font Size: Title: Times New Roman, 14, Bold

• Author details (Name, Designation, Institution, Email, Contact No.) below the title on first page.

• Abstract text: Times New Roman, 12, italics, 1.5 spacing.

GUIDELINES FOR FULL PAPER SUBMISSION

- Word Limit: 5000–8000 words (Excluding References).
- Footnotes: Bluebook 20th Edition (Times New Roman, 10, single spacing).
- Formatting:
 - Times New Roman, 12, 1.5 spacing, justified text.
 - A4 size, 1-inch margins on all sides.
- Headings:
 - o Title of Paper: UPPERCASE, Bold, 14.
 - Headings: UPPERCASE, Bold, 14.
 - o Sub-Headings: Title Case, Bold, 12.
 - o Sub-sub-headings: Title Case, Italics, 12.
- Co-Authorship permitted up to two authors.
- Plagiarism should not exceed 10%.
- AI-generated content should not exceed 10%; the work must primarily be human-authored.
- No endnotes or in-text citations—only footnotes.
- All submissions will be peer-reviewed. Papers accepted may require revisions as per reviewers' comments.

REVIEW AND SCRUTINY PROCESS

- All submitted papers will undergo three stages of scrutiny:
- Preliminary Screening: To verify adherence to formatting, plagiarism, and authorship guidelines.
- Peer Review: To assess academic quality, originality, and analytical depth.
- Final Selection: By the Editorial and Academic Committee for presentation and publication.

Papers that do not adhere strictly to the submission guidelines will be rejected at the preliminary stage.

REVIEW METRICS

- Originality and depth of research.
- Identification and analysis of issues.
- Clarity of argument and contribution to scholarship.
- Engagement with relevant jurisprudence and literature.
- Relevance to policy, practice, and innovation ecosystem.
