SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Categories of Submission

Research Articles: 4,000–8,000 words

Case Notes / Legislative Reviews: 2,000–4,000 words

Book Reviews: 1,500–3,000 words

Short Commentaries: up to 2,000 words

Author Guidelines

Submissions must be original and should not have been published or under consideration elsewhere. All manuscripts are subjected to plagiarism screening. Any paper with similarity exceeding 15% (excluding references) will not be considered.

Formatting

File Format: Microsoft Word (.docx)

Font: Times New Roman, size 12

Line Spacing: 1.5

Margins: 1 inch on all sides

Headings: Numbered with consistent hierarchy

Citation Style - Harvard Bluebook (20th Edition)

Abstract and Keywords - Each manuscript should begin with an abstract of 250–300 words, followed by five keywords that reflect the core themes of the paper

SUBMISSION PROCEDURE

Authors are required to submit manuscripts via the Online Submission Portal or email them to

submissions.ijlcs@gmail.com with the subject line:

“Submission – IJLCS [Article Title] - Volume I ISSUE II” .

All submissions must be accompanied by:

A short abstract (250–300 words).

Five keywords.

Author’s institutional affiliation and contact details.

Manuscripts will undergo initial editorial screening followed by double-blind peer review. The editorial decision will be communicated within 1-2 weeks of submission.
